

## **Krewe of Chaos Code of Conduct**

All Krewe members must conduct Krewe affairs in such a way that there can be no opportunity for unfavorable reflections upon the Krewe, either expressed or implied.

Endorsements, testimonials, publications, and participation in public affairs (particularly endorsements in the area of political affairs) should be undertaken by members cautiously and in a manner that clearly conveys that the activity is being undertaken as a private individual and not as an endorsement by the Krewe. Any communication, message, post or other similar dissemination of information made on any social networking website or via any electronic medium such as text messages or email which, in the Board's sole discretion, reflect unfavorably upon the Krewe could result in disciplinary action as described in Section 11 of the Bylaws of the Krewe of Chaos. Only those officers and Directors so designated by the Board of Directors may act as spokespersons for the Krewe and then only in the best interest of the organization.

The use of common sense, good ethical standards, and conduct which is in the best interest of the Krewe along with following all guidelines established within the by-laws of the Krewe of Chaos organization is required of all members. Failure to maintain reasonable standards will be cause for disciplinary action. Any violation of this policy may be the basis for disciplinary action up to and including termination of membership.
